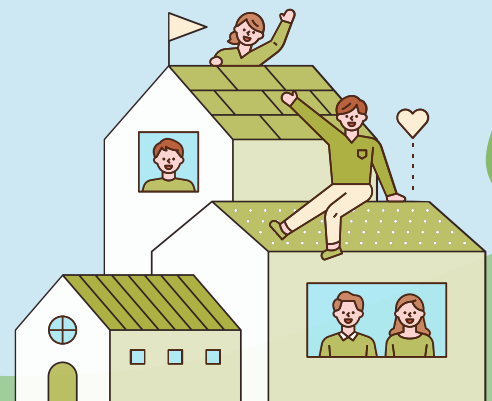

Living information guide

Notification of change of residence

- Report deadline: Within 15 days from the date of relocation of the place of residence
- Report place: Residential Community Center or Civil Service Passport Division (02-2091-2401)- (If 15 days have passed, a fine will be imposed, and the immigration office will report it)

Job counseling and job linkage

- Dobong-gu Office Job Plus Center (02-2091-2922-2923)
- In-charge: Civil Service Passport Division, 1st floor, Dobong-gu Office

National health insurance system excluding foreigners

- Foreign residents and overseas Koreans who have stayed for more than six months are naturally subscribed as health insurance subscribers, and adapt to the same insurance benefits as Koreans
- In-charge: Health Insurance Corporation (1577-1000)

Danuri Call Center

- Emergency and crisis support counseling, life information provision, etc. are provided in 13 languages for stable settlement of life for migrant women and multicultural families
- Operating Hours: 24 hours a day, 365 days
- Consultation Method: 1577-1366 Interview, Visit, Online (three-way call available)

Dobong-gu Office

- Provision of various information and services in Dobong-gu

- Discharge date: Designated day and time for each building (18:00~21:00)
- Purchasing volume-based standard bags: discount mart, convenience store, supermarket
- Discharge method

Food waste	Yellow plastic bag	
Recyclable waste	transparent plastic bag(paper, paper books, bottle, can, plastic bottle, plastic, scrap metal, vinyl, neon etc.)	
Product waste	Put it in a white volume-rate bag and dispose(Clothes and cloth generated while cutting medical care)	Frequent collection
bulky waste	sticker attached (declaration: Dong Community Center, district Office Internet Report)	Preserved Products (free collection) Call Center 1599-0903
special waste	Specially sized bags (sacks), remnants of house repairs, broken glass, blankets, pillows, etc.	Glass signs wrapped in newspaper

Korean language education for marriage immigrants



- Target: Marriage immigrants who wish to learn Korean Level 2 or higher
- Date: March ~ November
- Contents
 - TOPIK Certification Acquisition Class/Life Language Class Acquisition
 - Mon, Wed, Fri/Tue, Thursday/Saturday
 - Marriage immigrants essay writing contest
- Method: Center classroom face-to-face

Multicultural family visiting education



- Target: ① Marriage immigrants who have been in Korea for less than 5 years
- ② Immigrated children
- ③ 3 to 12 years old Children of multicultural family

■ Date: Whole year, 2X a week (2 hours)

■ Contents

- Korean language education: vocabulary, grammar, culture, etc. (Target: ①,②)
- Parent's education: Parent education for raising children
- (Target: Pregnancy, childbirth, parents of children under 12 years old)



■ Children's life: Homework and study guidance

Marriage immigrant's translation and information



- Target: Multicultural families and organizations that support multicultural families
- Date: Whole year
- Contents
 - Family communication interpretation
 - Translation of documents
- Method: visit, call, E-mail, Fax, outside duty, etc

Self-help group by nationality



- Target: Philippines and Cambodia Marriage immigrants
- Date: February ~ November
- Contents
 - Once a month
 - A gathering to share thoughts with daily life and share information
- Child's physical play, Enjoy the culture of the home country, etc

Employment support for marriage immigrants

- Target: Marriageimmigrants who wish to work
- Date: March ~ November
- Contents

- Date: All year
- Contents
 - Service connection, accompaniment, and schedule management that meet welfare needs
 - Provide related information for initial settlement in Korea, acquisition of nationality, immigrated children, etc.

Early settlement in Korea

Korean Society Adaptation Korea Program (Early adaptation program)



- Target: Foreigners in Korea who wish to stay for a long time (Marriage immigrants, immigrated children)
- Date: February~ November
- Contents
 - Education for foreigners residing in Korea necessary for social adaptation in the early stage of entry on basic law, life information, public morals, Korean culture, etc. (3 hours)

- Target: : Marriage immigrants and Immigrated children
- Date: March~ November
- Contents
 - Maximun 1:3 face to face jaranda education support
 - Korean study with Korean language volunteer one or twice a week

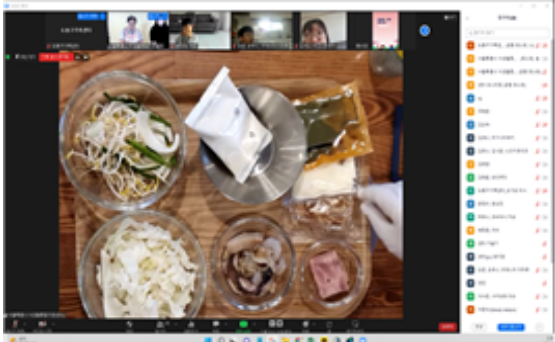
For children

- Target: Multicultural children below 12 years old (First priority to multicultural children, but children of foreigners and North Korean defectors may apply)
- Date: 2 times a week, 40 minute class
- Contents
 - Check language development level through language evaluation for multicultural children and provide 1:1 language development education
- In-charge: 02-995-6800(204#,205#)

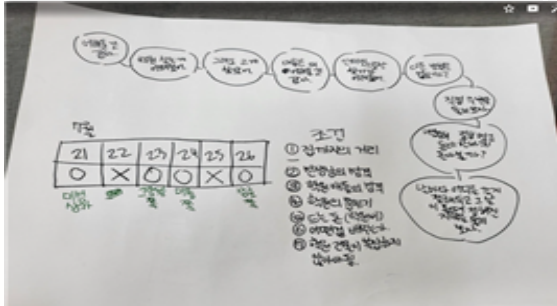
Multicultural Family Child Growth Support

- Date: May~ September
- Contents

Emotional stability and career support for multicultural children 'Variety'



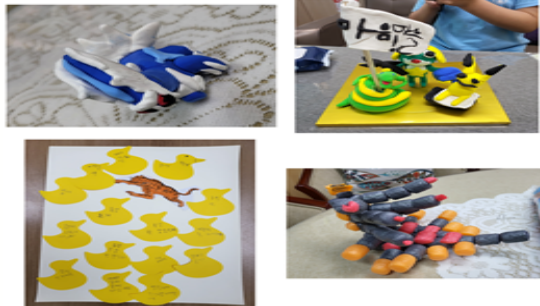
■ Target: Multicultural school-age children (7~18 years old)

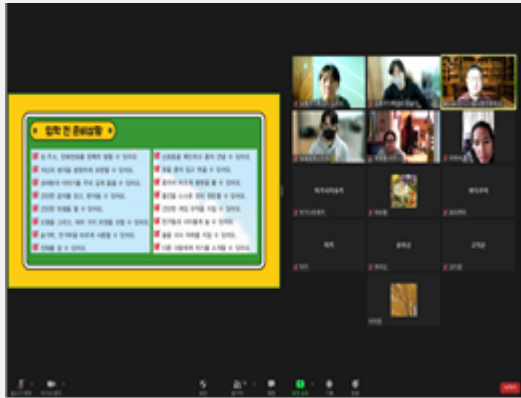

- Target: Married immigrants who have lived in Korea for 3 years or more
- Date: March ~ November
- Contents

Future design

Support for voluntary settlement design based on various needs for marriage immigrants who need preliminary preparation for life after initial settlement

Finding directions

Education for parent role support based on the needs found in future design, training for volunteer teachers to advance into social activities, employment trainingsupport

Service connection

Settlement stage package support in progress within the area, support to connect to the center program if necessary

Family Competency Reinforcement Project

■ Target:

- Adolescent parents(single) with less than 100% of the median income, single parents, grand-children, foreigners, families of multicultural and North Korean defectors, and family in crisis

■ Date : All year

■ Content

- Solve difficulties through 1:1 counseling, accompany

- Services given by experts (preschool children, elementary, middle school, and adolescent parent's 1:1 study guidance)

-Emergency/crisis support (related to professional counseling and treatment)

- Support for legal and psychological counseling expenses for adolescent (single) parents

- Health support through free medical treatment

Bilingual Environment Creation Program



■ Target: Multicultural family(Parents, Parent-child, spouse, etc.)

■ Date : All year

■ Contents

- To acquire the native language and culture of the child's parents , Parent's program(Parent-child, family may participate depending on the content of the program)

- Hosting a bilingual speaking contest for multicultural families
